Kindly keep track of the books your child reads this summer on the attached reading log. They may be returned at the start of the new school year.

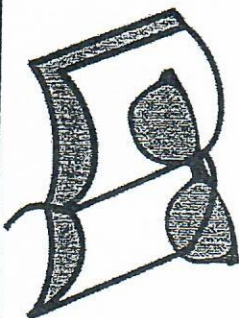
